### Father Stephen Hansen's Message . . .

I write you on Friday, April 19<sup>th</sup>, and am recalling being in the seminary on this day in 2005 when Pope Benedict XVI was elected. Besides all the joy that goes with "having a Pope again" after the death of one (Pope St. John Paul II), I remember how the next World Youth Day would be just a few months later in Germany, the home country of the new Pope. Providence had set it up that way. You might think of this as a stretch, but shortly after the Sisters in Jesus the Lord had been welcomed to St. Joseph, it was announced that the next international World Youth Day would be in Seoul, South Korea. I was so happy, I thought, just a short flight to Vladivostok to visit the Sisters' Russian mission. Then the war... Let us pray for peace, and let us pray that, if God's providence arranges, we can send young people from St. Joseph to World Youth Day, and then for a one-hour flight to Vladivostok!

As you know, from October through Easter, I was responsible for Our Lady of Guadalupe Parish as well as Cathedral and St. Mary's. I'd be lying if at times I wasn't overwhelmed. When a little sense of that was coming on, I thought of Bishop Johnston, who is responsible for twenty-seven counties. Now I think of Pope Francis on this anniversary of the election of Pope Benedict; they are responsible for the whole world! Let us always pray for our Bishop and Pope. I hope to see you at Our Lady of Guadalupe Parish this Sunday, any time between 4 and 7pm. Come have some dinner, and say goodbye to Fr. Armentrout, welcome to Fr. Nguyen and Fr. Fenlon, and welcome back to Fr. Malewski.

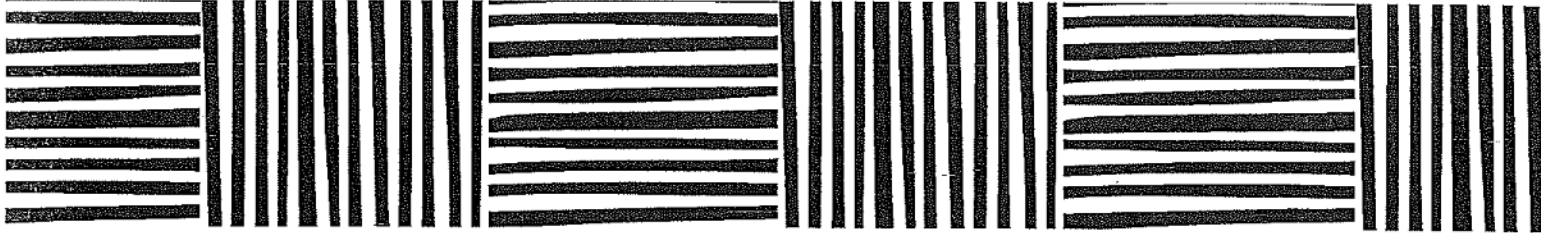
### Cathedral School News

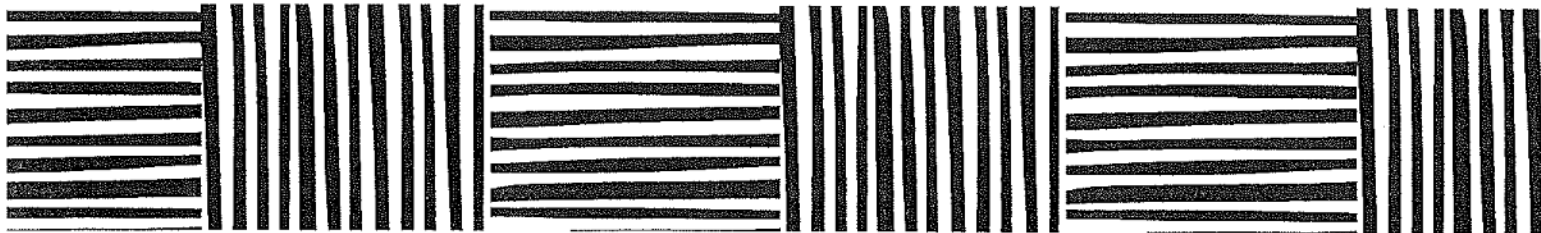

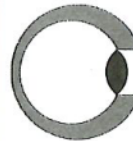
