A MESSAGE FROM FATHER HANSEN . . .

Last weekend I spoke about devotion to the Holy Infant of Prague. This week I gave a meditation to the Sisters of St. Francis of the Holy Eucharist and referred to the Infant of Prague but also to another devotion that the Sisters made me aware of, the Holy Infant of Good Health (which began in Mexico and is also known as Santo Niño de la Salud. you can learn more about that devotion at <http://catholicsaints.info/holy-infant-of-good-health/>)

As you know I moved the Infant of Prague up to the front of the church for at least the time being. Really, asking the Holy Infant to look over the great gifts that have been given to us in the properties. In the weeks to come, more information will be shared with you about how this has happened, I've already shared that at the weekend Masses on a regular basis.

Right now, I just want to share with you the prayers for the two main devotions to the Infant of Prague (which you can learn more about at <https://catholicsaints.info/infant-jesus-of-prague/>). Please consider praying one or both, asking for your own favors. Please pray them for the parish and her needs, as well!

The Nine Hour Novena prayers are as follows:

O Jesus, Who has said, "Ask and you shall receive, seek and you shall find, knock and it shall be opened," through the intercession of Mary, Your Most Holy Mother, I knock, I seek, I ask that my prayer be granted. (Make your request)

O Jesus, Who has said, "All that you ask of the Father in My Name, He will grant you," through the intercession of Mary Your Most Holy Mother, I humbly and urgently ask your Father in your name that my prayer will be granted. (Make your request)

O Jesus, Who has said, "Heaven and earth shall pass away but My word shall not pass away," through the intercession of Mary Your Most Holy Mother, I feel confident that my prayer will be granted. (Make your request)

The Chaplet of the Holy Infant Jesus of Prague prayers are as follows:

On the medal of the Chaplet (if you have one, it can be said without the medal) the following invocation is said:

"Divine Infant Jesus, I adore Thy Cross, and I accept all the crosses Thou wilt be pleased to send me. Adorable Trinity, I offer Thee for the glory of the Holy Name of God, all the adorations of the Sacred Heart of the Holy Infant Jesus."

Each "Our Father" (3) and Hail Mary (12) is preceded by the aspiration: "And the Word was made flesh and dwelt amongst us." On terminating the chaplet, say: "Holy Infant Jesus, bless and protect us."
