**Father Hansen's message . . . Happy 18<sup>th</sup> Sunday in Ordinary Time!**

I write you from New York (on Thursday, July 30<sup>th</sup>) where I've been in a Workshop since last Monday. I wrote about my trip in my last bulletin article...

First, I want to thank the good number of people who gave blood at the blood drive on July 25<sup>th</sup>! As I mentioned, my dad received blood sometimes three days a week. Your giving helps others in such situations/needs.

I had a wonderful couple of days with the Franciscan Friars of the Renewal upon my arrival in New York (before the Workshop). It appears that if I had not come early I would not have been allowed in New York without quarantine as Missouri has been added to their list... I visited with an old housemate from Pre-Theology who is now a CFR priest (Fr. Louis Marie) and I additionally had a nice visit, Holy Hour, and dinner with a friend who's in the women's branch of the CFRs, Sr. Catherine Mary of the Holy Trinity.

In my Workshop, we've studied cases most mornings, had a day of Recollection (quiet day) and had at least two meditations (1/2 hour each) per day. We made water excursions on the southern tip of Manhattan (got very close to the Statue of Liberty) and to the 9/11 site. Although the museum was closed the site was open; we walked, read many names, and prayed the Rosary. We've visited, cooked out, and watched movies among other things.

I leave tomorrow, July 31<sup>st</sup>, for Racine, WI, where I'll visit family... and return to St. Joseph on Tuesday afternoon. Please pray for my final days of the trip. I've been praying for all of you!
