Father Hansen's message . . . Happy 15th Sunday in Ordinary Time!

I just want to revisit last week's Bulletin article. Please keep all the Schools' Office personnel in your prayers as they work to see the Catholic Schools open this year. The sacrifice that we all make for the schools is not taken lightly by the Office. They have a great responsibility to be sure the kids are kept safe and their families, too, when they go home from school.

Additionally, last week I wrote about Mass times. Beginning next Sunday, July 19th, the Mass times will return to the times before the March outbreak of the virus and will be 8:30am and 11:30am. Beginning July 20th, Monday, Thursday, and Friday morning Masses will return to 8am. Tuesday morning Mass at the Cathedral will remain at 6:15am, Wednesday evening Mass will remain at 6pm, and the Saturday morning Mass will remain at 9am. The 8:30am Mass on Sunday will be live-streamed, and the 10am Mass will be discontinued. Mass will be at 9am on Federal holidays. All other live-streamed regular Masses, Adoration, and Rosaries will remain the same. Confession times will be for ½ hour before each Mass except there will not be any Confessions on Tuesdays, and Confessions will begin at 2:30pm on Saturday afternoons.

I want to take a moment to thank everyone for their patience and understanding, and support during these past months. We still have a long way to go in being sure all are safe, especially those who are older or medically compromised, but we've come a long way. Your financial support has been, frankly, unbelievable, too! Please keep that up!

Regarding the St. Gianna ECC, we're now told that we have two steps to make before we're fully licensed in the new facility. After we move in, the State Fire Marshall has to come for a final inspection. He is away for two weeks. The State Licensing Specialist has to make an initial inspection and then come back for a final one after we're fully moved into the new Center.
