### **Father Hansen's message . . .**

Happy 16th Sunday in Ordinary Time!

Today I head to New York for a Religious visit, a workshop, and then I return with a stop in my hometown. One thing I do when I go to my family visit (hometown of Racine, WI) is pray at the tombs of my mom and dad (I buried them both as a priest). You might recall that my dad had a blood disease that necessitated about three visits to the hematologist per week and then two to three visits to the hospital to receive blood. I say this as I did last year hoping that some of you (like last year) could give blood at the Knights Hall on Mitchell on Saturday, July 25th, between 7am and 1pm. Last year the blood drive was on my birthday, July 27th, and a good number of you sent messages and cards saying you gave blood for my birthday! Thank you and please consider such a gift this year, that's all I want (for those that can)!

Finally, recently I had the chance to visit on the phone with a ninety-five-year-old regular visitor to my last parish; I hadn't talk with her in two years. I asked her if she had advice for me.
