Father Hansen's message . . .

On this day in 1896, the only Church approved seer of the Blessed Virgin Mary, Adele Brise, died (https://championshrine.org/the-story/). Some parishioners from St. Mary's and Cathedral were able to visit the Shrine where Adele is buried two autumns ago . . . a very peaceful place to visit and pray. One of the requests of the Blessed Virgin to Adele was to: "teach the children their catechism, how to 'make the sign of the cross' and how to 'approach the sacraments.' Mary ended by saying: 'That is what I wish you to do. Go and fear nothing, I will help you."

What an amazing thing it is to see children discover the truth of a simple sign of the cross or to see their desire to receive their First Communion. I just watched a video of Bishop Johnston regarding his desire and intention to have the Catholic schools in the Diocese open this autumn! Let's pray for the schools' offices and their work to make that a reality and for the children to discover ever deeply the great mystery of the Faith!

I learned recently from the Vicar General that social distancing will continue to be a part of Sunday worship until a vaccine is developed to protect people from possible harm caused by the coronavirus. That being said, we'll be adjusting the weekend Mass schedule effective July 18<sup>th</sup> and 19<sup>th</sup>. Please watch for updates in next week's Bulletin and in an email as well. It's never easy to have Mass times change but, given the need to live-stream, to have six feet of distance, and to accommodate with the Cathedral's and St. Mary's space limitations, this has to be the case. Your cooperation will be appreciated.

Finally, I want to officially welcome our new Vicar, Fr. Timothy Leete. Father will be residing at the Cathedral rectory with Pius, the seminarian, and me. He'll have regular office hours at St. Mary's and office space at both parishes. Father Leete and I will continue to rotate regularly between St. Mary's and the Cathedral. I also want to welcome our new interim principal, Mrs. Gerre Martin. Mrs. Martin comes with great recommendations and has years of Principal experience. A formal hiring of a Principal following the Diocesan protocol will begin in October or November.
