Father Hansen's message.. Patrick, my brother, texted me... after he learned I was home with Covid. He and two of my sisters had Covid on Christmas, you may recall. I write you on my final day of quarantine with Covid and must say have taken some of my brother's advice; I've tried to keep busy. Beside my normal prayer schedule (not done with too much focus given symptoms...) and Mass, I've cleaned my residence. In that time, last night, I came across a folder my sister gave me, of all the things my mom had collected, even grade school report cards.

Today, the day I write (Friday, January 14<sup>th</sup>), is the 7<sup>th</sup> anniversary of my mom's death. I thought about writing in my article about sufferings offered up. I thought about more details of my quarantine, and how supportive people have been, especially Fr. Armentrout, my doctor of ten years or so, and also Dr. Flaska... But instead, I thought I'd write about my mom. One characteristic of her, which I hadn't thought about until after her funeral. Was that she never gossiped. I had asked two of my siblings who I happened to be standing with after the funeral, "do you ever remember mom gossiping?" No, they said. Margery Hansen (Peil) was born to a couple of young people who turned her over to St. Vincent's Orphanage in Milwaukee, Wisconsin. She was adopted by Joseph and Ester Peil and raised in their home with her older sister, Maryellen (who was also adopted). Simple life, Catholic grade school and high school. She went on to marry my dad, Eugene Hansen. Seven children later and fullness of life she passed on this day in 2015.

You parishioners have heard some about her and maybe this topic/characteristic before. I'd like to share again, though, given this anniversary. When you're tempted to gossip, or are in a setting when others are, consider these five points:

- 1. Change the subject.
- 2. Make an excuse for the person and what they've done that one might gossip about.
- Think of something good to say about the person (a good characteristic).
- 4. Walk away (from the conversation, or the thoughts in your mind).
- 5. Or, as my mom would do, tell the others to STOP gossiping (I sometimes say, punch, but not literally)!

I learned this morning that this day is also known as the memorial of Our Lady of the Word. In the year 1514, Our Lady was venerated at a Shrine near Montserrat, Spain. Her aid was invoked on behalf of a dumb man who went on pilgrimage there and the Blessed Virgin miraculously restored his speech. From that time on, she was given the title Our Lady of Speech.

In these ordinary time days, let's really be known as Christians who use their mouths to build people up - and fortify the spirits of others as my mom did, as Our Lady and St. Joseph did, as our Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ, did!

Presentation will include the meaning of suffering and death, moral medical decision-making, euthanasia and organ donation, and material and spiritual preparation for death. Parishioner and Director of the Life & Justice Office for the Diocese of KC- St. Joseph, Bill Francis, will facilitate an introduction to these topics, as well provide an opportunity for Q&A. Parishioner and local attorney, Arman Partamian, will discuss the basics of estate planning, wills, trusts, probate, non-probate transfers, etc.
