**Message from Father Hansen . . .** Last week I wrote of our entering into Ordinary Time for a short period (between Christmas Season and Lent which begins on February 17<sup>th</sup>). It occurred to me recently, and I have shared with the school children, the necessity to unite our ordinary lives (study, sports, work, and recreation) with Jesus for them to become extraordinary. But we also need to do our work well. One can't imagine Jesus not doing work well. A few weeks ago, I was working on a file for an annulment and was missing some of the paperwork. I took all the papers on and behind my desk and put them on the floor (in a big pile). Over two days I spent about seven hours going through everything, organizing and scanning. The order this brought to my life was amazing. I ask for your forgiveness for the times I have not had order and therefore have not been able to "work well" and get proper information at the proper time. I apologized to the couple whom this missing paperwork impacted (paperwork which I, of course, found in those piles). Again, I apologize to all of you who my lack of "work done well" has impacted. What do you need to do better this year? Where can you and I put more effort into preparation and execution of our prayer, work, study, projects, and even recreation? Let us not forget to also unite them with Jesus when we come to Mass (or attend via livestream at this time), where he will lift up our work and draw people to himself (Jn 12:32).

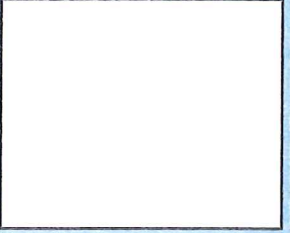

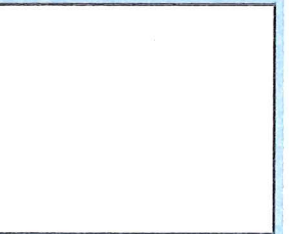
