Father Hansen's message . . .

Happy Easter!!!!!!! The Lord has risen!!!! I write this as I listen to Pope Francis preaching live in Rome for the Holy Thursday Chrism Mass. He's speaking of the Holy Spirit dissipating the fear of the Apostles, and that they no longer sought places of honor, nor thought about themselves so much...

Priests do receive an initial Anointing at Ordination, but they, I, have failed to always rely on that and disappointments have at time set in... I ask your forgiveness for the times you've, so to speak, paid the price for that because of me. However, today we celebrate Easter, the resurrection. The moment that all the words of Jesus took on new meaning. Why? He was/is God! He rose from the dead as he promised!

Pope Francis' mention of three temptations that can set in if we don't have recourse to the Holy Spirit and God's Mercy (Deacon Josh will write about this next week, maybe, as he writes for Divine Mercy Sunday): compromise, surrogate, & discouragement. When we feel discouraged, let's pray more, and consult, and not compromise on the call to holiness and call to apostolate we all have. Let's not substitute other things for the work at hand, the souls that need to know of the Mercy of God, and the Love of God poured out for us, especially in the Eucharist. Finally, let's ask the Holy Spirit to halt discouragement, and bring life back to our souls, sincerely trying to fulfill the desires of the Father. As we've seen the Son, we've seen the Father, and can know his will. The Holy Spirit, and his spouse, Mary, will help us, along with St. Joseph, the amazing patron of our city!
