Message from Mother M. Stella, CJD . . .

Some of you may be wondering where entrance, offertory and communion antiphons come from! For each Sunday, feast and solemnity of the year, there is a text chosen by the Church, especially for that day and liturgical season, usually from scripture, meant to be sung with psalm verses during the priest's entrance at the beginning of Mass, during the offertory procession, and while the faithful are receiving Holy Communion.

These texts are called "propers", meaning that they are specific to that day. The music for these texts for each Sunday, feast and solemnity is in the Graduale Romanum (Roman Gradual). Why have you probably not sung these at Mass before? Well, no standard edition has been published in English with music for the United States. The Latin texts set to Gregorian chant are easily available, but it has taken many years for composers to write collections of the propers in English. Twenty-two years ago when I became music director at a parish, I was only aware of one published book of propers in English, By Flowing Waters. Currently, there are more than twenty published collections of the propers in English, online and in print, and more are being written all the time. Some missalettes are even including music with the propers so the congregation can sing them.

It is exciting that we have the opportunity now to become familiar with these antiphons, chosen for each Sunday! I will write more soon about these propers, and about the ordinary of the Mass, too, which we also sing each Sunday. Keep in mind St. Augustine's famous words that "he who sings prays twice," for as we sing the words, they become part of us, enter more deeply into our souls, and conform us to Christ.

Calling all singers! Has anyone ever told you that you have a good voice? Would you like to be part of making our liturgies at Cathedral more and more beautiful? The Cathedral Choir sings at some of the 8:30 am Sunday Masses. Rehearsals are most Thursday evenings, 7 pm, in the church choir loft. Please call 816-500-6345 with any questions!




