#### A Message from Father Duc Nguyen

#### About the Angels

We tend to over-sentimentalize angels and to overlook their significance. Our appreciation for these pure-hearted beings will grow as we gain a deeper understanding of them. Let's start by learning some of the fundamentals regarding angels. There are numerous references to angels in the Catholic Catechism:

Angels have a significant role in the Church's overall functioning. In her liturgy, the Church joins the angels to adore the thrice-holy God. From infancy to death, human life is encircled by their vigilant care and intercession. "Beside each believer stands an angel as protector and shepherd leading him to life." Already here on earth, the Christian life participates by faith with the blessed company of angels and mankind united in God (CCC 334-336)

And according to our Lord, God has appointed an angel to watch over each of us.

See that you do not despise one of these little ones, for I say to you that their angels in heaven always look upon the face of my heavenly Father (Matt 18:10)

Nonetheless, there are numerous misconceptions that must be cleared up, many of which stem from television or movies. Namely:

Angels do not have bodies, and they have never been human. Humans do not become angels after they die, and angels never need to "earn their wings." Each angel is a person. Angels are created in God's image. But, unlike us, angels are pure spirits, thus they are neither male nor female. However, since we must imagine them in some way, it is not improper to imagine them as ourselves—with either masculine or feminine qualities. It is vital to note, however, that angels are beyond such distinctions. The prophet Daniel was given a vision of heaven and spoke of God, magnificently enthroned.

A stream of fire issued and came forth from before him; thousands upon thousands served him, and ten thousand times ten thousand stood before him (Dan 7:10).

Daniel could only see a hundred million angels, which is only another way of saying that their number is infinite. It is stated that when our Lord referred to himself as the Good Shepherd, who left 99 sheep to seek out one who had gone missing, the number "99" symbolized the angels left behind in heaven, while the "one lost" represented the human race. St. Anselm imagined that angels will outnumber humans 99 to 1! God appears to have a strong preference for angels!
