Message from Father Stephen Hansen . . .

Today marks the beginning of the octave leading up to Christmas. All the readings and prayers for Mass have a tone of the expectation of the first coming of Christ in Bethlehem.

In celebration of 800 years since the Church approved of the Rule of St. Francis, the Franciscan Family has requested and received a unique way for Catholics to get a plenary indulgence. So, from December 8, the Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception, until February 2, the Feast of the Presentation of Jesus, Catholics can be granted a plenary indulgence if they pray before a Nativity scene at a Franciscan church.

Although I'm not aware, as I write this, of a Franciscan church nearby, I invite you, this Advent and Christmas, to pray in a special way before a manger. Instead of using words that jump off the page for your mental prayer, consider looking at a character in the manger scene and imagining what it would be like to have been there, in the character's place, seeing the baby Jesus so vulnerable . . . God among us!
