Message from Father Stephen Hansen

Welcome to Advent! It's hard to believe that Christmas is three weeks from this coming Monday. The quickest Advent we can have.

I write to thank you for five things and to encourage you on two. First, thank you for your support of the Annual Catholic Appeal. All three parishes are already over 40% of their goal and the Appeal has hardly started. Please support this essential Appeal which helps the Diocese operate its many programs, along with the school and seminary formation for future priests. Second, thank you for your continued support of the parishes. Off the top of my head, I don't have increased giving memorized, but the Cathedral was up more than a little, which had led to our Annual Catholic Appeal goal going up \$6,000. Thirdly, thank you for your support of the schools. In our parishes we have two of the five campuses. Fourthly, thank you to those who have reserved the tax credits with MOScholars and Bright Futures. As I've said many times before, this is a game changer. 3. Save a copy of the receipt we provide. Include this and a MO-TC form with your state income tax filing. (For the current MO-TC form, visit <https://dor.mo.gov/forms/> and search MO-TC, pictured right.)

OTHER CONSIDERATIONS:

- Reserved tax credits are equal to 100% of an eligible contribution and can be used for up to 50% of the donor's annual tax liability. They may not be claimed as deductions.
- Tax credits may be carried forward for four additional tax years.
- Tax credits are non-refundable, non-transferrable, and cannot be sold.

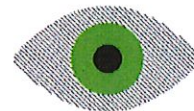

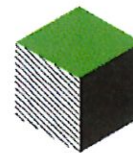
