## A Message from Father Stephen Hansen

Happy 4<sup>th</sup> Sunday in Ordinary Time! In our Diocese this is also “Called By Name Sunday.”

My spiritual reading book currently is *Through Wind and Waves* (by the author of *In Conversation With God*). Fr. Fernandez writes:

*A vocation is always a great gift, for which we have to give frequent thanks to God. It is the light that illuminates our daily life and work. If we were ignorant of this specific will of God that leads us directly to heaven, we would be traveling guided by the weak light of our own will, constantly in danger of stumbling. Our vocation gives us the light and grace we need to confront all the incidents of daily life. “A vocation provides a person, in a definitive way, with knowledge of himself, the world, and God. It is the reference point for judging accurately all the events of one’s daily life.” 18 [Illanes, *Mundo y Santidad*, Rialp, Madrid, 1984, p. 109.]*



Dear Brothers and Sisters:

Greetings in our Lord, Jesus Christ!

On January 31 and February 1, 2026, I have asked our parish priests to participate in *Called by Name Sunday*. From all eternity God has known each one of us by name and has a particular calling for us to follow. *Called by Name Sunday* is about listening and responding to God's call.
