**Father Hansen's message...** This week we celebrated Catholic Schools week. It left me reflecting on my twelve years of Catholic grade school and high school. Personally, on February 1<sup>st</sup> my family recalled what would have been my parents (Gene & Marge) 65<sup>th</sup> year of marriage! On February 2<sup>nd</sup> I recalled the 65<sup>th</sup> anniversary of my name sake's (Fr. Stephen Peil) priesthood anniversary.

Coincidentally, this week I came across a package my mom gave me a number of years ago before she passed away; my 5<sup>th</sup> grade report card fell out of the package. Needless to say, Catholic schools aren't perfect. Nor was I a perfect student. There are difficulties in growing up, family life, school life, and life in general. Pope Francis witnessed this, along with the many joys (no doubt including the million people that attended the main Mass) in the Democratic Republic of Congo. He was apparently silenced by stories shared by children, and what they go through in the war torn Congo. Pope Francis said striving for peace is the answer and it all starts with forgiveness!

Bishop Johnston spoke at the All Catholic Schools' Academy Mass for the children of St. Joseph. He spoke of the five parts of a good team, and the Academy is a team. They were: players, coaches, training, others before self, and health. The Bishop shared that the team wins when the players are successful and happy in this life, and that they attain eternal life.

I'm sure the Bishop would agree with Pope Francis that difficulties experienced in school are healed (good health, the last of his five points) with forgiveness! Let us enter Lent in a few weeks with the desire that, by Divine Mercy Sunday (Sunday after Easter Sunday), we can forgive all we hold hardness of heart toward... and that those we've offended forgive us!

We thank God for our Catholic Schools! We thank God for the new MOScholars which has enabled many new children to enter our Catholic Schools! I might add that on February 1st, the MOScholars Fund was opened for the 2023/24 school year. 
