A Message from Father Duc Nguyen

It is traditional to be devoted to one single aspect of our Catholic faith during each month of the year. We remember the Holy Name of Jesus in the month of January.

Jesus' name means that "God is salvation." The name Jesus was chosen in heaven at the moment of the Annunciation, according to the announcement made by the angel Gabriel. "Behold, you shall conceive in your womb and bear a son, and you shall name him Jesus," (Luke 1: 31). We pray to the Father in Jesus' name, assured that our request will be heard. "Whatever you ask in my name, this I will do, that the Father may be glorified in the Son. If you ask me anything in my name, I will do it," (John 14:13-14). The Church administers all sacraments in the name of Jesus. She offers forth all prayers in Jesus' name, casts out evil spirits, and bids us farewell at the hour of our death. "Go forth, Christian soul, from this world in the name of Jesus Christ who redeemed you." The name of Jesus, therefore, has power and is not to be taken lightly. St. Paul told the Philippians, "At the name of Jesus let every knee bow, of those that are in heaven, on earth, and under the earth and let every tongue confess that the Lord Jesus Christ is in the glory of God the Father," (Phil 2:10-11).

A prayer of love for the Holy Name of Jesus:

Eternal Father, who didst give to thine incarnate Son the holy name of Jesus to be the sign of our salvation, plant in every heart, we beseech thee, the love of him who is the Savior of the world, our Lord Jesus Christ, who lives and reigns with you in the unity of the Holy Spirit, God forever and ever. Amen.
