Father Armentrout's message . . .

Every year on January 25th, the Church celebrates the Conversion of St. Paul. This feast day stands as an important reminder, at least for me, of the power of prayer and God's grace. A man who thought he was justly persecuting the nascent Church, through the promptings of God's grace, came to realize that he was persecuting the same God in whom he believed. His whole life, it seems, could be redefined by this one instance - his meeting with Jesus on the Road to Damascus. One could imagine that his encounter with the person of Christ motivated his beautiful writings on grace and justification in the letters to the Romans and Galatians! It certainly inspired the advice he would give to young bishops in the letters to Timothy and Titus. In this encounter, he learned that all of his gifts, his zeal, his energies had been falsely directed - and this is something that Jesus would purify within him - so that he could become a great instrument of conversion in the life of the Church! Let us ask St. Paul to pray for all of us, that we might grow in our zeal to spread the *Truth of our Faith* - that is the person of Jesus Christ!

If you would like to jog your memory on the conversion of St. Paul, consider reading: Acts 9 or Acts 22! Also, consider looking up Caravaggio's painting of the conversion of St. Paul if you would like an image to pray with while you reflect on the passages. Feel free to join us for Mass on Wednesday night to celebrate this great feast day.


