Father Hansen's message... Earlier this past week Fr. Armentrout and I were driving to a meeting and called the Convent of the Sisters in Jesus the Lord; we chatted with Sr. Joanna and she passed on the phone to Sr. Catherine who had just returned from Russia (and a trip to the Holy Land). We welcomed her "back to America." Friday morning, I was able to greet her in person and asked if Sr. Joanna has let her get any sleep. Sr. Catherine responded, "five minutes."

I'm sure as Sisters they've been catching up on things in Russia and America. But, those five minutes of rest were important, too. This is true for our time with God, resting in Him. When I came as pastor in 2018 the first change I made was to beg, if you will, for Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament especially during the school year and the school day. We now have it in summers on Wednesdays and Thursdays. 


