Message from Mother M. Stella, CJD . . . Loving God and Neighbor—a Little Examination of Conscience

"You shall love the Lord, your God, with all your heart, with all your being, with all your strength, and with all your mind, and your neighbor as yourself." Luke 10: 27.

Here are some questions that come to mind when I hear or read those words:

- --Do I love the Lord with all my heart? What in my heart have I not yet surrendered to God? Am I holding on to something that I love more than God? Is there anyone in my life who has hurt me that I have not yet forgiven?
- --Do I love the Lord with all my being? Do I praise and thank Him for all the blessings He pours out on me each day? Do I sometimes look back over my life and thank Him for how He has blessed me in the past?
- --Do I love the Lord with all my strength? Do I love God with passion? Do I give Him the first minute of my day by rising the minute my alarm goes off in the morning? Do I seek out extra ways to love Him?
- -Do I love the Lord with all my mind? How often do I speak to God as I go through the day? Do I take time to read the Bible or a good spiritual book to help my thoughts be filled with Him? To help me to start thinking the way Jesus does, to "put on the mind of Christ"?
- -Do I love my neighbor as myself? Do I think about myself more each day, or my neighbor? Do I look for ways to help my neighbor? If I see someone in need, do I take time to stop and help?

Lord, please grant me the grace to love you with my whole heart, with all my being, with all my strength, and all my mind, and my neighbor as myself.

The greatest help that I have found in my life for growing in each of these areas is to bring everything to the sacrament of Confession. Jesus pours out His grace on us every time we come to Confession with a contrite heart and gives us His strength to become more like Him! At one time in my life, I went to Confession once a year, the minimum required to be a good Catholic. However, I discovered that I could only remember my sins from about the past month! When we go to Confession more frequently, such as monthly, every two weeks, or even every week, then we do not have to hold on to our sins so long, and we get much more grace from God to overcome them.

On a different note, Fr. Daniel Maurer, CJD, from our brother community, the Canons Regular of Jesus the Lord, is going to be here in St. Joseph on August 1-5! On Wednesday, August 3, after the 6pm Cathedral Mass, Fr. Daniel and the Sisters in Jesus the Lord will give a presentation on their mission in Vladivostok, Russia. Hope to see you there!
