#### Message from Father Benjamin Armentrout . . .

A lot of my time this summer has been spent reading. I've read theological books, some Russian literature, the statutes for the Diocese of St. Joseph written in Latin in the 1930s, the scriptures, canonical commentaries & articles, and daily news. All this reading has led me to consider when I first started to enjoy books that I wasn't forced to read! Perhaps one of the first books I enjoyed reading was *Harris and Me*. I believe I was in the fourth grade. Around the same time, my grandma would take my brother and me to the library where I would check out well written Non-Fiction books about the Ringling Brothers, The Wrights, Thomas Edison, the Presidents, and other American figures! In high school, I recall taking one of those online tests that are supposed to give you some sort of psychological insight. It asked: 'what is something that your friends likely wouldn't know about you?' And my answer: 'I like to read.'

One author, and I don't remember who said it but only that he said it, highlighted the importance of reading in his claim"The purpose of reading- and any serious study for that matter- is to prepare our hearts for the infusion of Truth." Reading well
requires we silence our own thoughts to immerse ourselves into the thoughts of another. We then incorporate what we have
gleaned from other authors into our daily lives and conversations. One important way to help us become more comfortable
sharing our faith with others is to read about our faith in spiritual books and to learn the essence of the faith through prayerful
reading of the scripture. As this summer comes to an end, I encourage you to set aside a few minutes each day to learn something
about our great Catholic Faith by reading a classic spiritual work and a short passage from the scriptures. In making such a
concerted effort, we prepare our hearts for the infusion of Truth and dispose ourselves to share that same Truth with others!

I look forward to seeing you soon. I will return to St. Joseph before the weekend Masses on August 6th! -Fr. Armentrout
