#### Message from Father Stephen Hansen

As I mentioned last week from Lincoln, Nebraska, while I was at the Institute for Liberal Catholic Education Conference, today is World Day of Prayer for Grandparents and the Elderly. I also mentioned last week the today is my birthday. I mention this in light of an interview I had with a reporter, Jack Figge, from "The Pillar."

When I think of the characteristics and virtues of Charles Untz, who the article\* is about, I think of his education and formation – as we learned about at the conference – and how that made Charles prepared to receive the love and gifts God wanted to give him, which included a desire to be a Saint!

Secondly, in the article there is reference to my encountering Charles in prayer. That "encounter" occurred in the seminary in St. Louis on October 27<sup>th</sup>, 2000, when I was praying before Mass. Later in my seminary days, a faculty member, Msgr. Witt, was giving a conference and suggested to the seminarians that if we were called to the priesthood, the Lord intended it from the day we were conceived. I remember thinking about how a normal pregnancy is nine months, and then calculated back nine months from my birthday, July 27<sup>th</sup>, which was October 27<sup>th</sup>. I happened to be praying for a friend, who was conceived by assault, when I had that encounter.

We are all called by God, not just priests and sisters, and we want to be predisposed as much as possible to hear His voice. Let us pray for Kent and Amie and their colleagues in the school and ECC. Let's pray for all our schools in town and the diocese, and moms who homeschool, that they never forget the gift they have in teaching and forming these young people. Let's also pray that life is understood and respected from conception – no matter how a child is conceived - until natural death!
