A Message from Father Benjamin Fenlon . . .

Oftentimes, when we see priests doing different things at Mass, we think they just have their own styles or preferences. Sometimes that is the case, but normally there is actually a rhyme and reason to everything. One thing that we take into account very much is whether a Mass is 'high' or 'low' in our mind.

A work of art is not just pastel colors, but must include tonality and shading to be beautiful. A piece of music is played with white notes and black notes, majors and minors, that complement each other and form harmonies above a simple catchy tune. So it is with our Masses.

The Latin Mass had a very clear distinction between High and Low Masses - a low Mass was pared down. Daily Masses are all low Masses, but not all low Masses are daily Masses. A Sunday early morning or evening Mass could be low too. At a Low Mass there is no music or singing, no incense, two altar servers, two candles, and surprisingly for us, no homily.

A high Mass, that is to say, a special Mass for the community (think, the Sunday morning Mass), has several incensations, lots of servers, 6 candles, music, and the priest would sing the prayers, Gospel, and preface (that is the part with 'the Lord be with you').

This is an important distinction, and we do try to keep it more or less, because having a simple, silent experience of God in Mass helps us to get to know him, whilst celebrating a solemn Mass helps us to appreciate just what it is we are partaking in.

If you never come to Mass on weekdays... why not give it a try, just one day a week for a month? You might find that you really love it!
