A Message from Father Stephen Hansen . . .

Twenty-six years ago today (July 7th), I made the decision to withdraw from medical school and go to the seminary. It was one of the hardest decisions of my life. As the current chaplain to the Catholic Medical Association in St. Joseph, I admire what our doctors, nurses, and other medical professions do on a day-to-day basis. Of course, I have the privilege of being helped by them, and you all do, too.

In the book of Numbers, we read of Moses making a brass serpent/snake and putting it on a pole, and that those who look upon it will live. In John's gospel, Jesus refers to Moses' serpent/snake and that the Son of Man must be lifted up, and those who believe will have eternal life. Later in John, Jesus says that when he's lifted up, he will draw all people to himself.

What a privilege we have to look upon our Lord on the Cross and be changed, healed in a way. Our difficulties become meaningful. We can take our failures to Confessions, and furthermore be strengthened and directed after receiving Communion. I'm grateful to the doctors and medical professionals for all they do; they're amazing! I'm grateful, too, that God called me to the priesthood, where my focus shifted from healing the body to the soul. This summer, may we all look up to our Lord on our crucifixes in our homes and in the Church. Let's ask Mary, our mother, to help us see new ways of uniting our sacrifices in this life with the one Sacrifice of her son on the cross!
