A Message from Father Stephen Hansen. . .

If today were not a Sunday, it would be the Optional Memorial of the minor Patron Saint of our Diocese, St. John Francis Regis. There are two things about this French Saint that I recall learning that might be of interest to you. First, he is known as one of the Patron Saints of hospitality. I imagine one reason is St. John Vianney ran a couple of schools/orphanages, and one was out of grain for bread... St. John Vianney put a relic of St. John Francis Regis in the grain room, and in the morning the room was overflowing with a new harvest!!! The second recollection was that St. John Francis Regis wanted to be a missionary to French speaking Canada. He was never able to make it physically to Canada (nor to accompany French missionaries to the United States), but now he is available to help Canadians (and Americans) from heaven!!

May St. John Francis Regis' intercession help us today, to be generous in our giving to our food pantry (who served a record 69 families this past Monday) and help us to have a missionary spirit in sharing the Faith with others, bringing the hope of Jesus Christ!!!
