### Message from Father Stephen Hansen

As we continue our journey in Ordinary Time, this week being the 12<sup>th</sup>, we also celebrate Father's Day. For some reason I have this memory of my dad, Eugene Walter, cooking fried chicken on Father's Day, and I think it should have been a day of rest for him...

Fathers don't rest too often, neither do mothers. St. Joseph and the Blessed Virgin don't rest too often either. They intercede for those who go to them, and even for those who are just in need, to their Son with great familial love!

As the pastor (and one of the Fathers) of Cathedral of St. Joseph and St. Mary's in St. Joseph, I thank you for both parishes working together these now eight years I've been here. On one occasion, I hope you don't see this as gossip, a family was returning to St. Joseph to bury their parent. All were from out of town. I don't recall all the details, but I recall asking the office ladies at Cathedral to call St. Mary's Altar Society to see if they could host a luncheon as the school had activities in Ruggle Hall and the gym. Of course, the ladies at St. Mary's were thrilled to help. The family, though, told the funeral director, no thank you. We want to be at Cathedral, we went there. Then the funeral director said to me "Father, they've not been here in twenty years, they don't know we work together."

Well, I'm sure the parishes in town have always done their best to work together. These days, we're all dealing with Mass time changes. I know this is never easy. The request of Bishop Johnston to reduce the number of Masses was because we're losing a priest to a new assignment. Additionally, the Cathedral can hold over 700 people and neither Mass on Sunday total 300 people. It was clear to me that given St. Mary's 10 am Mass was approaching capacity, and that time slot, along with the 11:30am people, would not hold everyone. Additionally, given Fr. Davis chose to eliminate his Mass at the 7:30 am slot, there might be some who would still prefer an earlier Mass and 8 am might suit them. I'm sure there could be reasons for not having the Masses at 8 am, 9 am, 10 am, and 11 am on this side of town. However, that's what Fr. Davis and I came up with, and the Bishop was happy with our plan. Over time, if things keep moving upward, we'll need to add a Mass again. In the meantime, I hope we will all see a continued increase in seminarians, and future priests, to match the demands in the pews.

On this Father's Day, please forgive me for my many failures, and pray too, that St. Joseph and the Blessed Virgin Mary will intercede such that I can serve the Church with greater zeal and charity!

I want to, this weekend, thank Fr. Fenlon for all his sacrifices and service these last 2.5 years. He began by jumping in to help at Our Lady of Guadalupe when I was administrator there. His work with the Spanish speaking faithful in town and those at St. James and St. Patrick's have been appreciated in many ways, beside his work at St. Mary's and Cathedral, including the school. Thank you, Fr. Fenlon!
