A Message from Father Benjamin Fenlon

I read a lot of stuff written by saints, and recently it has impressed me how often and highly they talk to us about SPIRITUAL READING!

This means, having a good book that you are working away on to cultivate Holy thoughts in your mind every day.

It's not about reading a lot, or about reading difficult things. It's about reading SPIRITUAL things so that we think less about the world and more about God.

Every Baptized Catholic should always be reading a good spiritual book. Even if it's just one page a day, or one paragraph... but something to make you think and pray.

How can you find a good spiritual book? If you are just starting out, make sure that you are reading a book by a **Saint**. If they are a Saint, it means the Church approves of them! St. Alphonsus Liguori, or St. Francis de Sales, for example.

Secondly, make sure it is a book that is **spiritual** in nature – even if someone was a saint, if they were a lawyer, then their law books are not considered spiritual reading.

Once you have started reading these things, you can branch out by looking up the authors that the saints hold up to you as examples.

Reading spiritual books is a recipe for success: it will shake you out of our routine and fill your heart and mind with love, fear of the Lord, hope, joy and peace. So, get to a bookstore, or online (TAN books is pretty awesome!) and start today!

May proved to be a very busy month at the **Cathedral Food Pantry**, including one day when we served 69 households in less than 2 hours! We are extremely grateful to our **Cathedral parishioners**, and friends at Our **Lady of Guadalupe** and **St. Mary parishes**, for their children's food drives.
