#### Father Leete's message . . .

This month we celebrated the feast day of Saint Boniface, known as the Apostle of the Germans because of the work he did to convert those people to the true Faith. Born in the 7<sup>th</sup> century in England, he left that country to do missionary work in what is present day Germany. The people there had suffered under apathetic priests and bishops and as a result the faith was lukewarm at best and in many cases had lapsed back into paganism. He labored many years and brought countless souls back to the Church. At the age of 73, while preparing to confirm some of his flock, he and his 52 companions were attacked and murdered by a band of pagans.

To the end of his life, Boniface displayed courage. He preached the truth fearlessly. He fought against the world, the flesh and the devil, never allowing a fear of any of those things to silence him.

And how do we react when we are threatened by the rich and powerful? When they threaten our source of funds or our comfortable lifestyle, do we stand for the truth or do we cower and grovel before them? Is truth more important to us or is money? Our response should be the same as St. Peter: "Let your money perish with you!" (Acts 8:20)

We should imitate St. Boniface and all the martyrs throughout Church history who went to their deaths loudly proclaiming the truth to a world that can't stomach the truth, a world that doesn't consider the truth to be "pastoral." Pastoral is simply another word for cowardice, a craven fear of challenging the rich and powerful. Don't be a coward. Stand with the martyrs. Let us be neither dogs that do not bark nor silent onlookers nor paid servants who run away before the wolf. Instead let us be careful shepherds watching over Christ's flock. Let us preach the whole of God's plan to the powerful and to the humble, to rich and to poor, to men of every rank and age, as far as God gives us the strength, in season and out of season. ~St. Boniface






