#### A Message from Deacon Joshua Fultz

""I thirst" is something much deeper than Jesus just saying, "I love you." Until you know deep inside that Jesus thirsts for you - you can't begin to know who He wants to be for you. Or who He wants you to be for Him." — St. Teresa of Calcutta, March 25, 1993

Wednesday evening Mandy and I took the opportunity to have a date night and go watch the movie "Jesus Thirsts: The Miracle of the Eucharist." I thought this would be the perfect opportunity to give a quick "Deacon's Review" of the movie.

We didn't really know what to expect going in. Being that we are still in the Eucharistic revival I thought it probably would be a "rah-rah" movie for the USCCB's efforts. I was pleasantly surprised to see that it was something far more. This movie takes the time to tie each of the facets of the eucharistic miracle back to scripture and give Catholics a deeper meaning to what many take for granted, the real presence of the Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity of Jesus Christ.

While this intrigued the church nerd in me, the movie then went deeper to discuss eucharistic miracles which really got me fired up. You think I got excited about talking about the eucharist before, I'm really on fire now! I did not know that in 2008 there was a eucharistic miracle in Sokolka, Poland. They took sample from this miracle and put them under an electron microscope. If you don't know what that is, it can look WAY beyond a normal microscope to the structure of a substance. They found the host to contain BOTH the material of bread and human flesh from a human heart. THE COOLEST PART: the flesh was growing out from the bread! They were basically ONE. Now my spiritual nerd brain was chatting with my science nerd brain, and they were both getting really excited. Then the movie hit my evangelical button.

It reminded me that too many people don't know, believe, or even care about the eucharist and it's up to us as faithful and believing Catholics to spread the word. We can't rely on a movie to do the work for us. The theatre wasn't even close to being filled. We have to be Jesus' hands and feet and go out and show his love to people and tell them that he is waiting here for them in the tabernacle! If you get the chance, I highly suggest you find a way to watch this movie and get fired up because we've got some work to do, and I'll be looking for some help!
