### A Message from Fr. Stephen Hansen

I write you from the Charles Anthony Francis Untz childhood home, in Andover, Minnesota. You may recall my sharing over the years about Charles, who was hit by a car 25 years ago today (I write on Thursday, March 20<sup>th</sup>), and died. With this sadness, there is a light that lives on. Charles' Eagle Scout goal was: "My life purpose is to do the will of God. My ambition is to become a saint. There is nothing harder to achieve than this, but I will continue to strive for it." This year, with Xavier Schmidt here at Cathedral, we were fortunate to have Xavier reach out to Charles' dad, Steve, after he learned that Charles' Eagle Scout project was to write an altar servers manual. Xavier adapted that for us and has started a little club, with assistance of Dan Pfister and Joe Wise, that Xavier calls "Our Lady's Knights." The priests that knew Charles call him "My Lady's Knight" after it was recalled that Charles simply called Mary, "My Lady." You are welcome to take a Charles Untz prayer card from any of the exits at St. Mary's or the Cathedral, we always have supplies of cards out.

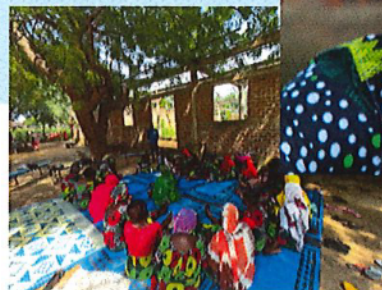
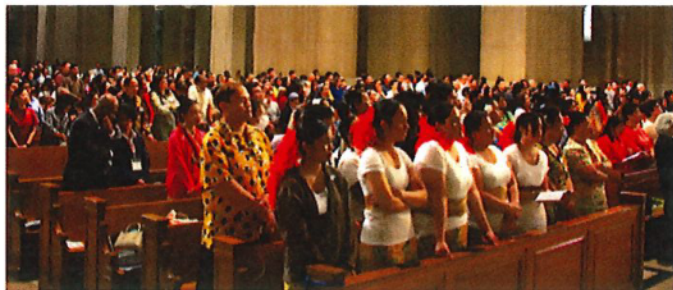

For people living in developing countries around the world, lack of access to traditional financial services keeps them from providing for their material needs. A Catholic Relief Services (CRS) program has created Savings and Internal Lending Communities (SILCs) to address this lack by helping poor communities to pool savings, which then can be lent to SILC members to build or grow businesses at low cost. 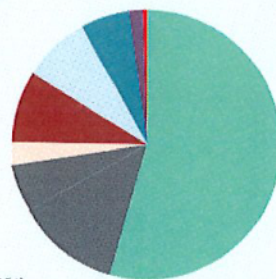

Pero ahora, estos ahorros en los costos le permiten mantener a su familia y cubrir las matrículas escolares.

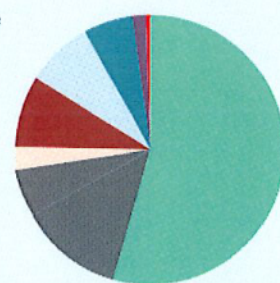
