A Message from Deacon Joshua Fultz... We Have a New Pope!

Since the death of Pope Francis, the world has been abuzz with speculation. And just like everything else these days, the conversation has felt a lot like the last presidential election—polarized and loud. Will he be conservative or liberal? "I think 'insert name here' is the best pick because he'll either 'continue' or 'shut down' what Pope Francis started." Everyone has an opinion.

But in the midst of all the noise, I find myself resonating with something Bishop Barron said: It's not about politics—it's about choosing the one who will preach the resurrection of Christ. That's it. That's the heart of it. In this age of instant opinions and digital debates, we risk losing sight of what truly matters: the Pope is not a pundit or politician. He is the Vicar of Christ—called to proclaim, with boldness and humility, the life, death, and resurrection of Jesus.

Our Church—made up of all of us imperfect people—is still very much alive. She breathes because she draws her breath from her Creator. That's why we call her *Mother Church*. She's there for us at every stage of life—from baptism to burial. She welcomes us in, scolds us when we need it, and wraps us in mercy every time we come to the confessional. She doesn't do it alone, either. She's covered by the mantle of our Biessed Mother, who protects the Church and all her children with the kind of love only a mother can give. So, this weekend, while the noise makers debate whether Pope Leo XIV is the "right man for the job," let's take a step back. Let's celebrate *our mothers*. And let's ask Mary, our Biessed Mother, to pray for our new pope and for our Church in the days ahead.


