In this instance, the parishioner suspected a scam and stated he would stop by the parish office to take care of the matter. The caller attempted to talk the parishioner out of this before the call ended. The parishioner then contacted his Parish Office. Our Diocese asked that all parishes be alerted about this scam. Neither the Diocese nor any location would contact a donor asking them to change the bank account for their electronic donations.
