#### Message from Father Stephen Hansen . . . Venerable Fulton J. Sheen and Saint Teresa of Avila

I write after leaving our last religious site on a pilgrimage with Religious Ramblers, the Cathedral of St. Mary's in Peoria, where Venerable Fulton J. Sheen is buried. After Mass, which I offered for our Vocation Director, Fr. Nathan Rueb, and his work, I had a chance to do mental prayer before the Tabernacle and the mortal remains of Ven. Sheen. Usually, I do thirty minutes of mental prayer before Mass. Today, because of having to offer Mass right away after arriving at St. Mary's, I had to do mental prayer before the Tabernacle after. I prayed over three quotes of Ven. Sheen that I'd like to share with you:

"The Assurance of God's Mercy": "Oh, what greater assurance is there in all the world of the mercy of God? Lost sheep, prodigal sons, broken Magdalens, penitent Peters, forgiven thieves! Such is the rosary of Divine forgiveness," from *The Seven Last Words*.

"The Climb": "Heaven is a city on a hill, hence we cannot coast into it; we have to climb. Those who are too lazy to mount can miss its capture as well as the evil who refuse to seek it," from *The Seven Capital Sins*.

"Undying Love": "There are only two words in the language of love: 'you' and 'always.' You because love is unique; always because love is enduring. No one ever said, 'I will love you for two years and six months.' All love songs have the ring of eternity about them," from Three to Get Married.

I share these out of reverence for Ven. Sheen, but also because if today were not a Sunday it would be the Memorial of St. Teresa of Avila. St. Teresa coined the phrase "mental prayer" and is a Doctor of the Church, showing that mental pray for everyone. After each ten minutes of prayer over the three quotes I tried to make resolutions. You can do the same as you pray over the things that grab your attention in Scripture or the spiritual books you read. Books of quotes by Saints can also be good things to pray over, along with books written for mental prayer such as three books by St. Josemaria whose relic is in the back of the Cathedral: The Way, The Furrow, and The Forge.

Happy praying!!!! Ven. Fulton Sheen and St. Teresa of Avila, pray for us!


