Loving greetings to each of you from the three of us in Russia! It is also "back to school" time here—OCIA started last week, and parish school of religion starts this Sunday. We are hosting a parish picnic at our convent on Russian Island this Saturday and especially hope that it will be a time for deepening friendships and a rekindled desire for some to attend and/or return to Mass.

It is such a grace for us that we are united with you in prayer! We have experienced so many blessings lately—we hosted the Catholic far Eastern young adult conference at our convent, Dom Marii ("House of Mary") the last week of July, then a friend came to stay at our convent for the weekend with her son who had just been released from prison after sixteen years. Ten sisters and a priest came to stay with us last week for a community vacation, and a young woman is visiting for three weeks discerning her vocation. This evening, a recent college graduate came to stay with us for a week before she returns home to Kenya. Next week, we will make our annual community retreat (September 17-25), this time in Khabarovsk, a 13 hour train ride north of Vladivostok.
