This Sunday, Pope Leo will canonize Carlo Acutis, and he'll become Saint Carlo Acutis! Wow! It seems like just yesterday one of our school moms and teachers, Amy Roetto, made me aware of Carlo before his Beatification. Now, this... Wow, again!

This call we all have to be saints, renewed in our minds by Vatican II, and before that now St. Josemaria, is a high calling. One of the things Carlo was known for was his love of the Eucharist. Another was how he'd defend kids being bullied by others. Charles Untz, from Minesota, was known for his holy purity and heroic obedience to his parents. 
