#### A Word from Fr. Stephen Hansen

This coming Monday we celebrate Labor Day. Of course, we think of the beginning of Fall, our cookouts and picnics. Maybe you have other traditions you recall and live out this weekend. And we, of course, think of the dignity of work. This brings to mind the memories of the labors of my mom and dad. I remember going to the office with my dad (he was an accountant at Modine Manufacturing) and being impressed with the good amount of adding machine paper he went through (no computers back then). I even remember his retirement.

But over time and learning about one of the Saints whose relic in in the back of the Cathedral – St. Josemaria Escriva – I started to see the spiritual good in work. In preparing for a meditation, I'm giving this weekend in the spirit of St. Josemaria, I prayed over the examination of conscience question that will be read out loud: "Grant, we pray, that, always attentive to the things that are above, we may merit to be sharers of her glory' (Mass of the Assumption, Collect). Am I trying to live in such a way that the fruits of my actions give glory to God?"

To think that our "labor" actions can give glory to God makes labor something very different. St. Josemaría's message was that "labor" is sanctifying and needs to be sanctified. There are two things that need to happen for this to happen. One, we need to do our work (labor) well. Whatever it is. Second, we need to offer it to God as prayer.

As we continue our journey in Ordinary Time, let us do our work well and, when offering it up, let's offer some up as prayer that the Amendment 3 proposal – which would enshrine abortion as legal to change our State's Constitution - fails!
