*Blessed are the poor in spirit, for theirs is the Kingdom of Heaven.  
Blessed are the meek, for they shall possess the land. (Matt 5:3-4)*

**Father Hansen's message** . . . I wrote this before leaving for my annual silent retreat (January 24<sup>th</sup> – 29<sup>th</sup>) after coming in from welcoming the children with the teachers on a cold morning. It's the 10<sup>th</sup> day of my covid quarantine and mask wearing. I was wearing a mask, a black hat with ear coverings, and my winter coat over my cassock. . . One boy, I think in the second grade, looked at me with confidence and said, "you look like a cowboy priest!"

On January 25<sup>th</sup> we concluded the annual octave of prayer for Christian Unity. This high calling was proclaimed by our Lord shortly after he instituted the Eucharist before his crucifixion. In John 17 we read our Lord's words: *I do not pray for these only, but also for those who believe in me through their word, that they may all be one; even as thou, Father, art in me, and I in thee ... that they may be one even as we are one, I in them and thou in me, that they may become perfectly one, so that the world may know that thou hast sent me and hast loved them even as thou hast loved me.*

When I was in seminary in St. Louis and our class was entering Theology I (the first year of major seminary) together, we were all asked to introduce ourselves. One of my classmates was from Vietnam studying for the Diocese of Dodge City Kansas. He introduced himself as "a Vietnamese cowboy." Although it wasn't a cold day, and he wasn't wearing a big black hat, we chuckled as I did this morning when the boy said I look like a cowboy priest. By being united - as priests, as Catholic Christian faithful, in parishes and in towns, and in dioceses and the Church universal - we have an amazing opportunity to leave a good example to our separated Christians friends who are not receiving the Eucharist at this time.

I wrote two weeks ago about "gossip" and some antidotes to it (inspired by my mom's example). Anything that causes division, gossip being at the top of the list of causes, needs to be rooted out before those separated will receive the Eucharist with us. Being Catholic means being universal. European American or Vietnamese American, African, Micronesian, Mexican, Indian, or Russian. May our Lord, his mother and our mother - the Blessed Virgin Mary - and St. Joseph, help us along with St. Paul to be one and root out causes of division, and may we be used to bring our separated brothers and sisters into full communion, so that *the world (St. Joseph...) may know that thou has sent me (us) and hast loved them...*
