Message from Father Hansen... I was in a meeting recently and someone asked me to "set up online giving" for a certain cause. Those of you set up with online giving at Cathedral know what this means. I don't believe St. Mary's has online giving set up yet. In the finance committee meeting a few days later, we talked about my giving a little update on finances from the pulpit one weekend coming up, and establishing giving through PayPal, Venmo, and Square. The nice thing about setting up online giving at the Cathedral site (https://www.myowngiving.com/Default.aspx?cid=1500) is that there aren't any fees. The other options may include fees. We hope to have other options set up soon, but today I'd like to point out three extra options for Lent/Alms:

- 1. Pius' Rome Experience Fund. Total needed there is \$2,000. He's received an \$8,000 scholarship but the rest (2,000) must be raised for that to kick in. You might recall we raised monies for Jared for the same cause.
- 2. Rose Vestments/Blessed Virgin Mary Vestment Fund to complete the full array of vestments for the Cathedral. Total to be raised, \$6,000. Some has been raised and is being tracked by Liz Winkelbauer. We only have \$4,750 to go!
- 3. March 6th Fundraiser for the Cathedral School. Please consult the Bulletin, but also look here: https://felixstreetgourmet.company.site/Cathedral-School-Fundraiser-c79672337 Watch for pledging/donate on dinner at the Rectory for 12!

How can a pastor not be grateful for all the causes that people bring to him? I hope you're not offended by my suggestion for at least part of your extra Lenten giving! I look forward to addressing you soon from the pulpit on the update on finances, too!

Finally, on February 10th I emailed a statement about the principal search. We continue to make progress and I want to thank (and will name later) the seven faithful parishioners and Pius, with their breadth of life and educational experience, have been directly and indirectly invaluable in this process. Watch for an update soon.
