#### Message from Bryce Hunt . . . The Lenten Journey

The Season of Lent is a time of preparation for Easter, when we celebrate the Resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead. Many have summed up the opportunity and relationship of these two seasons with a quip, "No Cross, No Crown." The Gospel reading from Matthew 5 on Ash Wednesday offers three practices to engage in for reflective living by which to enter into the mystery of the self-giving and unconditional love by which Jesus entered into his Passion, Death, and Resurrection - all in order to fulfill his purpose of reconciling us to the Father, so that we might move from Sin into Righteousness, out of Darkness into Light, and from Death into Life. Those three practices are Prayer, Fasting, and Almsgiving. We can enter more deeply into the mystery of God during Lent as we pray, fast, and give for the benefit of others. We know what to pray - the prayers of the Church. We know what to add to our prayer life in the form of self-denial of the desires of the flesh. We know what to give from the treasure God has already provided us, which helps both others in need, and ourselves to imitate the generosity of God with us. Few of us, myself included, have been taught how to pray. Our congregations, Cathedral and St. Mary's, have provided a rich resource in a Lenten book, "I Saw God Laughing", by Matthew Kelly. He gives us a model for praying by which we can learn how to pray as we are praying. This short book opens a door for us to be more deeply formed as Saints of God who want to become more like Jesus and share with others what we have found in closer communion with God. Pick up a copy of the book. Read the book. Become more proficient in prayer, and the love of God and of those with whom he daily brings us into contact. Become more alive than you've ever been.
