Message from Father Hansen... Today we will finish a "big" week in the parish and if I may say in the city. We are in a special year in the Church, too, the Year of St. Joseph.

In ordinary life there are time we talk about ordinary things. It is good to talk about ordinary things and to offer them to God! We can unite everything we do: joys and sufferings, ambitions, successes, and even failures. All sacrifices can be united with the one sacrifice that takes place at the Mass (the representation of the sacrifice of Christ, himself).

One of the sacrifices we can offer is our treasures. Two weeks ago, I preached about balancing the financials for this extraordinary year and putting us on a trajectory for a balanced budget next year. If you could consider making a sacrifice of \$56.25 more per month you would help with both. Next fall, we will include a pledge card for the parish along with the Annual Catholic Appeal for our planning purposes. We return to the pledge cards, and I write this, at the recommendation of those serving on the Finance Committee: Tom Roetto. Taira Garvey, Judy Hausman, Pius Nsoh-Awasom, Todd Ehlert, and Ron Barbosa. I am grateful for them in sacrificing their talents to help us.

Next week we begin the "biggest" of weeks. It is said that Easter is to the year what Sunday is to the week. As we prepare for Holy Week that will lead to Easter Sunday, let us talk to our Lord a lot - the Blessed Virgin Mary and St. Joseph, too – asking for their help in fighting the temptation to miss Mass on Sunday. What a gift the Eucharist is to nourish our week, but also what a gift to unite our ordinary life and sacrifice with Jesus, our Lord and Savior!






