Father Hansen's message... Today we celebrate Mother's Day in the United States. Just the other day I was recalling summers in my hometown of Racine, and I asked the children what they are doing in the summer. I remember particularly the 4th of July; there was a parade that had attendance close to the population of the city! I now recall Mother's Days. The thing that stands out the most was that my mom was served on that day, she could do no serving... Well, Happy Mother's Day to all you mothers, and to all you women who are mothers through your feminine genius! Feminine genius was a term coined by St. John Paul II. His Apostolic Letter, *Mulieris Dignitatem* (On the Dignity and Vocation of Women) has become a classic on this topic.

St. John Paul's first trip out of Rome after his being called to the papacy was to Mexico City. There he visited his heavenly mother's image, the image of Our Lady of Guadalupe. On December 12th, 1531, Mary told St. Juan Diego "Am I not here, who is your Mother? Are you not under my protection? Am I not your health? Are you not happily within my fold? What else do you wish? Do not grieve nor be disturbed by anything."

On this Mother's Day, let us pray hard for our mothers on earth and for those that have gone before us. Let us serve them! Let us also turn to our mother in the order of grace, and *not grieve nor be disturbed by anything*!




