Deacon Garrett King will be ordained to the priesthood on Saturday, May 29 at the Cathedral of the Immaculate Conception in Kansas City. Father Garrett King will celebrate his first Mass here at the Cathedral on Sunday, May 30, at 2:00 PM. Everyone is invited to attend.

Father Leete's message... Pentecost marks the occasion of God sending the Holy Spirit, the third Person of the Holy Trinity, upon the Blessed Mother and the Apostles after Our Lord's Resurrection. The book of Acts describes how the disciples were gathered together in one place on the day of Pentecost. The Jewish feast of Pentecost (Shavuot or the Feast of Weeks) was a day that commemorated the giving of the law to Moses. Now the law of love was to be written in the hearts of the faithful by the Holy Spirit, so that his yoke might be made sweet and his burden light (Matt. 11:29). Nothing is difficult for one who loves. This is why we should strive to serve God, not out of a servile fear, but with the love of a child, which we all are by baptism.

The Holy Spirit desires to fill us with an abundance of his 7 gifts: wisdom, understanding, counsel, fortitude, knowledge, piety, and fear of the Lord. No one is excluded from receiving these gifts, but we must open our hearts to them. We must make a conscious movement of our will toward the Holy Spirit. Importantly, we must seek quietness of mind and inward peace. He cannot fill a soul that wanders aimlessly and carelessly longs for material comforts and possessions.

We can invite the Holy Spirit to come into our hearts with the following prayer: Come Holy Spirit, fill the hearts of Thy faithful and kindle in them the fire of Thy love.

- V. Send forth Thy Spirit and they shall be created.
- R. And Thou shalt renew the face of the earth.
- O, God, who by the light of the Holy Spirit, did instruct the hearts of the faithful, grant that by the same Spirit we may be truly wise and ever rejoice in His consolations. Through Christ Our Lord. Amen.
