Why? It's that important. Please consider...

Last weekend after my preaching at the 4pm Mass I learned a parishioner asked for a recipe for how to give to **Bright Futures/MOScholars**. Before I give the "recipe," I first want to share a little background on the MOScholars. After years and years (over twenty) of dialogue with Representatives... in Jefferson City, there were six approved organizations across the State of Missouri to give scholarships through donations made and where the doners receive 100% tax credits (claimed over five years) up to 50% of their State of Missouri tax liability per year. Please see your past tax returns or consult your tax accountant as to what is the maximum credit you can claim. This funding of private and religious schools was ratified by the Supreme Courte in July of this year.

The "organizations" I refer to above are called Education Assistance Organizations (EAO's). Each of them is primarily focused on specific communities. For instance, there is an organization focused on the Jewish schools. The Herzog is working with many schools around the state. But, very importantly, the Bright Futures Fund is focused solely on the Catholic Schools in the Diocese of Kansas City - St. Joseph for MOScholars tax credits.

That being said, the "recipe" is: First, gather the amount you've paid State Income Taxes on and decide what your donation/tax credit will be. For example, if you pay \$2000 in State Income Tax (SIC)/year you can claim a credit of \$1000 this year. You could donate \$1000 or \$5,000 now and claim all this year if you've donated \$1,000 this year and \$1,000 each of the next four years if you've donated \$5,000 this year. Then, go to: https://www.brightfuturesfund.org/ and click "Reserve Your Tax Credits Here"

That will take you to: https://treasurer.mo.gov/MOScholars/ReservationApp

Now, state whether you are giving as an individual, corporation, partnership...

Very important, select from the "EOA List" "Bright Futures Fund."

Fill in the fields, including the amount to be given/tax credit requested. There is a \$500 minimum donation/tax credit.

After you've completed the form, you'll hit "Submit" and then, you'll see a screen that says: "Your reservation has been successfully submitted! Your confirmation number is ..."

Send that confirmation number and the check to: Bright Futures Fund, PO Box 419037, Kansas City, MO 64141

Safe Haven Sunday 2022

Dear Friends in Christ,

This weekend we are again celebrating Safe Haven Sunday throughout our diocese. The goal is to raise awareness about the issue of pornography and how parents can help their children navigate the use of mobile devices, computers and social media. This effort was inspired by the U. S. Conference of Catholic Bishops' statement *Create in Me a Clean Heart: A Pastoral Response to Pornography*. This is done in many dioceses in our country on dates chosen by each bishop.

Today's readings speak of God's unfailing love and mercy. They also speak about how important it is to respond to God's love and mercy.

Parents, you have a gift for your children. You can help communicate God's mercy and His desire for their good through their use of computers and mobile devices. Today, adults and children often have anonymous access to content that is not only graphic, but frequently violent and perverse. Many forms of social media were designed in a way that gives predators and other bad actors easy access to users. Without your involvement, your children are likely to be impacted in ways that harm their human dignity and, with growing frequency, even their safety. When parents bring light, truth, and mercy to their children they can find a way forward to mature and safe use of technology. As your bishop I want to help equip you for this daunting task.

Our Diocesan Vision, One Family: Restored in Christ – Equipped for Mission calls us all to be equipped for our mission to make disciples. To this end, I invite you to use a free seven-day text-to-join program that provides practical guidance to create safer digital environments. We have partnered with Covenant Eyes to provide this free educational program and a free month of access to their monitoring and blocking software. On the prayer cards for Safe Haven Sunday, you will find the text-to-join information for the Safe Kids program, a QR code for the free e-book Connected: How Strong Families Lead to Internet Safe Kids, and the website for our local support programs. If you have a smartphone, I give you permission... no, I ask you, right here in church, to send the sign-up text... right now. You simply text "SAFEKIDS" (as one word, with no space between safe and kids) to 66866.

I invite you to consider using monitoring and blocking software like Covenant Eyes, Bark, and other similar options. Learn the facts about the dangers, make a plan, pray, and make your plan a reality for the sake of your children and their future.

Our children are precious gifts from God. Thank you for all you do to raise them as disciples of Jesus Christ.


