You may have heard as we began to conclude the year, that Pope Emeritus Benedict is declining in health. In his general audience on Wednesday, Pope Francis said "I would like to ask you all for a special prayer for Pope Emeritus Benedict, who in silence is supporting the Church. Remember him - he is very ill - asking the Lord to console him, and sustain him in this witness of love for the Church, until the end."

When the Lord calls 95-year-old Pope Emeritus Benedict home, it will be the first time there was a recorded funeral of one Pope for a Pope Emeritus. One common characteristic of all the Popes during my lifetime is love for Our Lady. In fact, Pope St. John Paul II's motto was *Totus Tuus*. Which means, totally yours, Mary! We ask Our Lady to watch over Pope Emeritus Benedict in a special way these days!

As we begin this new year, maybe one resolution we could make, if we haven't already, is to begin the year praying a decade of the Rosary after dinner with our families! If we're single, we could pray the decade looking at an image of the Holy Family, or a statue of St. Joseph or the Blessed Virgin Mary. Over time, hopefully we'll get to the point where we're praying the whole rosary every day! 
