Deacon Joshua Fultz's Message . . . Trust in the Divine Mercy of Christ

I often wonder if trust has ever been easy for me to give. As far back as I can remember, there have been very few people in my life that I have truly given my trust to. There could be many reasons for this, or possibly just a few depending on how I look back. This lack of trust has led to a cynical attitude toward society and the people around me. This is something I would like to change, especially after reading paragraph 300 from the *Diary of St. Faustina*. In this paragraph, Jesus says to St. Faustina:

"+ Mankind will not have peace until it turns with trust to My Mercy. Oh, how much I am hurt by a soul's distrust! Such a soul professes that I am Holy and Just but does not believe that I am Mercy and does not trust in My Goodness."

This stopped me in my tracks tonight as I searched for something to write about. It made me ask myself, "Do I trust in Jesus? I mean, **REALLY TRUST** Him and **HIS MERCY**?" You see, it's easy to speak the words "Jesus, I trust in you," but there is a big difference between saying it and believing it deep in your soul.

I will have to spend some time with this, and maybe you will too, because if we truly desire to believe in Christ's Mercy, we should begin to show it to the people around us. It requires that we examine our hearts and ask some tough questions. How often have I been quick to judge people's actions based on nothing? How many times have I lashed out in anger due to my selfish desire to be right, justified, vindicated, or any of my other prideful inclinations? Do I show Mercy to those who do not deserve my Mercy? That's what Jesus does. He bathes me in his Divine Mercy every time I step up to receive his body, blood, soul, and divinity in holy communion.

Jesus, **MY LORD** and **MY GOD**, help this poor sinner to **TRUST** in You and **Your Mercy**.

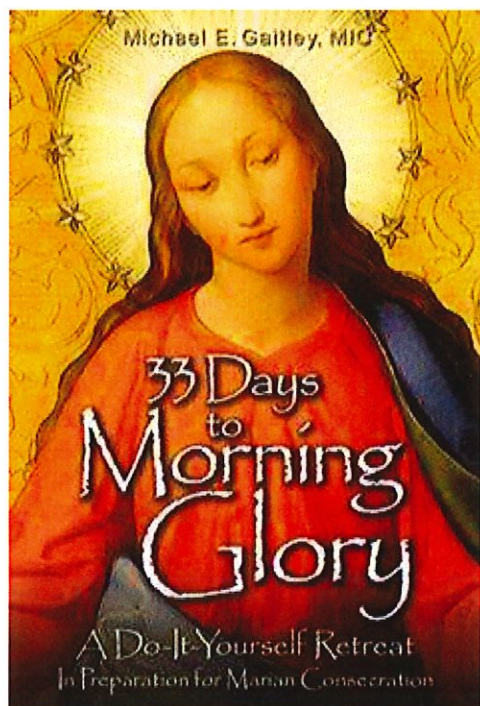
