Father Hansen's message . . .

Holy Week is here!!!!! On this day, April 2nd, there were two deaths I want to briefly write about. First, in 2005, was the death of the now Pope St. John Paul II. As we enter Holy Week, maybe you have memories of him shaking with his Parkinson's disease while carrying palms on Palm Sunday... or the Cross on Good Friday. I do. He was physically weak but strong with Christ.

The other person who died on this day, which you may be surprised at my mentioning, was Robert W. Schuller. He died 10 years after Pope St. John Paul II. When I was away from the Catholic Church in late and post college until beginning medical school, I watched Robert Schuller every Sunday, the *Hour of Power*. It's my understanding the Robert Schuller sold the Crystal Cathedral to the Diocese of Orange (at a lower price than other offers) because he wanted Sunday services there (not just to be used as a college campus building). It's now called the Christ Cathedral of the Catholic Diocese of Orange. When I would watch the *Hour of Power* televised from the Crystal Cathedral, I learned of guests like Bishop Fulton Sheen and St. Mother Teresa of Calcutta, a Catholic in the way to sainthood, and a canonized Saint. I thought, why were they invited?

As we walk through Holy Week, let us be mindful of the gift we have as Catholics with the Real Presence of Jesus in our Tabernacles. Although there wasn't one in the Crystal Cathedral, there is one now. Let's be thankful for Christ's presence in all who pray together. Let's be thankful for Christ's presence in his Word. Let's be thankful for Christ's presence in the priest and let's take advantage of their time in the confessional some time in this month of April. Please, please, please, take a Divine Mercy Novena pamphlet with you this weekend or on Good Friday. The Novena prayers begin on Good Friday and conclude on Easter Saturday, in anticipation of Divine Mercy Sunday (the next day)!


