**Dynamic Parish Summer Reading** This week's pick from the Lending Library is "Consecration to Saint Joseph" by Fr. Donald Calloway MIC. In this year dedicated to St. Joseph, learn more about the life, the wonders, the power, and the ceaseless love of St. Joseph, Universal Patron of the Church, and the Terror of demons. This is the first comprehensive 33-day program of consecration to St. Joseph; information on the 10 wonders of St. Joseph; and prayers and devotions to St. Joseph.

*"I am the living bread that came down from heaven, says the Lord; whoever eats this bread will live forever. (John 6:51)*

**Father Hansen's message . . .**

This Sunday we continue in the Bread of Life Discourse in St. John's Gospel, Chapter 6. When looking up Bread of Life Discourse in the Catechism of the Catholic Church, you'll find several entries. One, the first, is this entry 1373: "Christ Jesus, who died, yes, who was raised from the dead, who is at the right hand of God, who indeed intercedes for us," is present in many ways to his Church: in his word, in his Church's prayer, "where two or three are gathered in my name,"<sup>198</sup> in the poor, the sick, and the imprisoned, in the sacraments of which he is the author, in the sacrifice of the Mass, and in the person of the minister. But "he is present ... most especially in the Eucharistic species."

Here, the Catechism quotes the Second Vatican Council, Sacrosanctum Concilium – the Constitution on the Sacred Liturgy. This quote emphasizes the presence of God at Mass and of course refers to God's presence when the Gospel is proclaimed or read with eyes of faith. Prayer in our families brings Christ's presence. When we go to Confession, we hear the priest say, "I absolve you, in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit." It's humbling to say, "I absolve you..." and it's also humbling when I go to confession (and hear those words, too). But in the Council document quoted in the Catechism we read "most especially in the Eucharistic species."
