In the month of July, our Food Pantry served 510 households, which was made up of 1559 individuals (977 adults and 582 children). The volunteers worked a total of 250 hours (which includes the 90 minutes the Food Pantry is open per day, 3 days per week, and the time spent purchasing, transporting, loading/unloading, and stocking items. The Food Pantry recently set a new record of 60 households served in one day. That breaks down to one household served a cart of food every minute and a half! We thank our volunteers for their ongoing dedication and service to helping those in need. We also thank all our parishioners, other parishes, organizations, vendors, and friends of Cathedral who assist us, when they can, in helping the hungry. #### Message from Father Stephen Hansen . . .

I write on Thursday, August 4<sup>th</sup> (the Memorial of St. John Vianney) from New York Cty where I'm on a priests' workshop. Twenty-seven priests from around the United States (one from England) are together with classes in the morning and early evening. Sunday we'll have a quiet day through midafternoon. Each Thursday we have a day set aside for excursions. Today, three of us went to the 9-11 Museum.

I just got out of a get-together with the priests after dinner a few hours after the excursion ended. Someone asked how the 9-11 museum excursion went. I'll share the three most memorable things brought up by the three priests.

Fr. Will (from Arlington) said the room with the faces of all 2977 people who lost their lives was most touching. He reflected on how one was only five years old. Not in that room, but outside where all the names are listed, there are a number of names of the woman and "her unborn baby." Unborn, to five, to older... all races, ethnic backgrounds, religious.

Fr. Ryan (from Chicago) wrote of a "burly" man with his wife and two kids, was just balling (crying). That really touched Fr. Ryan.

I thought a big picture of Fr. Judge's body being carried by a fire fighter, police officer, and a stockbroker was most touching. Fr. Judge was a Franciscan priest who went into the Twin Towers to anoint and did not survive.

We'll see you all next weekend! Welcome back, Fr. Armentrout! Welcome back, school children!
