**Deacon Joshua Fultz's Message . . . "**My son, do not disdain the discipline of the Lord or lose heart when reproved by him; for whom the Lord loves, he disciplines." *Hebrews 12: 5-6* 

If you spoke with my mother, I am sure she would tell you I was not always the best son when I was growing up. Quite often, my southbound bum collied head on with a northbound wooden spoon. That was her discipline of choice when her sons would get out of line, but each one of us deserved it. We were no angels, and we still get threatened with a wooden spoon from time to time. While this discipline was no fun, and through tears we may have told our mother how mean she was, it was necessary. As I look back, I can see in each of those moments, lessons that were needed in order to make sure I would become the man I am today.

It's the same when we receive discipline from our Heavenly Father. He, however, doesn't use a wooden spoon; He uses the consequences of our free will choices. Sin is a choice and every time we make the choice to sin and turn away from God, we also subconsciously choose our punishment. It's important that we understand that God doesn't inflict our punishment on us, but He does allow it to happen to us for our own growth and because He loves us.

Like a loving parent, He wants us to see our error, accept responsibility for what we have done, and then ask forgiveness. It was no different with my mother. Each one of those steps was important and each one had to be taken, and then forgiveness would be granted along with penance. Whether that meant doing what was asked to begin with or making reparations for whatever we broke. Maybe that is why I don't fear confession, because I know no matter what, God loves me and wants to forgive me. He may ask me to say some prayers or take some other action to repair the damage my sin has done, but I know it's all in love and ultimately for my betterment.
