A Message from Father Stephen Hansen

It's hard to imagine the school year is about to begin! It was a joy to see the Cathedral teachers and staff at Mass on Thursday! I said to them, and I think of it in light of the Gospel passages these last weeks (and in light of the National Eucharistic Congress), that love is sacrifice. To love these children, takes sacrifice. But so does marriage, being a religious or a parish priest. Being a Christian is about sacrifice because we follow the Lamb of God who sacrificed Himself on the Cross! He offered Himself to the Father, freely, to take away the sins of the world!

As we go about our ordinary life these days, when so many families are transitioning to a school calendar, let us be thankful for those who have sacrificed for us to be where we are today. And, when we come to Mass (maybe trying to get there a little earlier than normal), let us recollect and present to Jesus to present to the Father, our sacrifice united with Him. 
