Father Hansen's message . . .

In a recent Sunday homily, I shared a definition of Catholic Liberal Education. It went like this: "... "Catholic liberal education," ... speaks to the end—the purpose—and expresses the irreplaceable role of the Church. Liberal comes from the Latin liber, which means free. Catholic liberal education, then, is an education for freedom: freedom in Christ as he reveals Himself through His Church. This formation does far more than prepare a student for a job. It frees us to know, to love, and to live joyfully in the Truth of Jesus Christ."

To form and educate our children to be "joyfully (living) in the Truth of Jesus Christ" is not easy. Throughout the history of the Church, Saints have been raised up to guide us in education. We can think of the great American Saint, St. Elizabeth Ann Seton. In fact, when I was in New York, I prayed at the house she lived in on the southern tip of Manhattan, where she welcomed Irish immigrants fleeing the potato famine... I write on August 19th, the memorial of St. John Eudes. He was a great formator in seminaries. In fact, 22 years ago today I entered the seminary in St. Louis, where I first learned about him. Here are some words he wrote about education in seminaries: "Our wish, our object, our chief preoccupation must be to form Jesus in ourselves, to make his spirit, his devotion, his affections, his desires, and his disposition live and reign there. All our religious exercises should be directed to this end. It is the work which God has given us to do unceasingly."

May this school year, for the children and us adults, move our hearts and minds to conform more to "live joyfully in the Truth of Jesus Christ."
